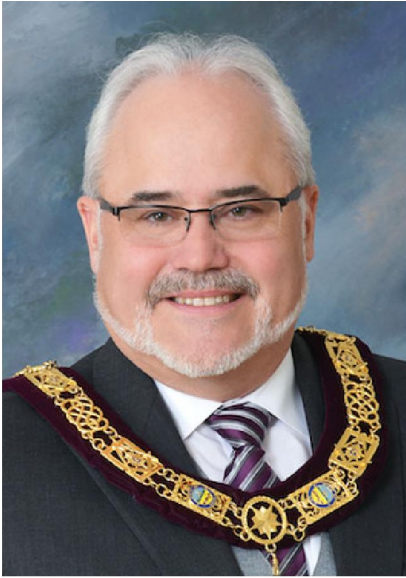

The messages will come in from the Grand Lodge of Ohio (no_reply@grandview.systems), so make sure this address is allowed in your email system, otherwise it could be stopped by your spam filter and you will miss out on important information from our Lodge.

Do You Need To Pay Your Dues Or Want To Make a Donation?

You can now pay your dues or make a donation on-line with Visa or MasterCard safely and securely through the Grand Lodge of Ohio payment system. Just go to your Member Portal on Grandview and look for the "Pay Now" or "Donate Now" button near the upper right corner of the page. Follow the instructions and you're there. Convenient, simple and easy. (There is a small fee for using this service to cover the costs incurred by using a credit card.)

Are you on Grandview yet? Currently, not all of our members have taken the time to go to this site and set up their member portal. It's simple; only requires one's membership number and the email address you have given the lodge. You will set your own password and then you can keep your records current for us (a blessing to the already overworked lodge secretary).
